17.2. First Interim Report (2022-2023)

The Education Code requires school districts to submit interim financial reports twice a year. The First Interim report reflects actual transactions through October 31, 2022 and must be submitted to the County office of Education for review in December 2022.

As part of the First Interim report, each school district must certify that its financial status is positive, qualified, or negative. Each of these terms is defined below:

- A positive certification means that the district will meet its financial obligations for the current fiscal year and subsequent two years.
- A qualified certification means that the district may not meet its financial obligations for the current fiscal year or two subsequent years.
- A negative certification means that the district will be unable to meet its financial obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year or for the subsequent fiscal year.

As discussed in this report, the South Whittier School District is submitting a positive certification for the 2022-2023 First Interim Report.

The information attached highlights changes since the adopted budget and projections for 2022-2023, 2023-2024, and 2024-2025.

The Superintendent recommends the Board of Trustees approve the positive certification for the 2022-2023 First Interim financial report as presented.

The Unrepresented Classified Salary Schedule 7 will increase pay for AVID Tutors to \$15.50/hour to comply with California minimum wage effective January 2023.

17.4. Resolution No. 22-23-008: Carmela Real Property

Approval of Board Resolution No. 22-23-008. Under the terms of our existing long term Ground Lease with FairField Carmenita LP, as the Tenant, they have the right to assign the Leasehold Interest to a third party, provided that the District consents to the Assignee within thirty (30) days of being notified of the Tenant's desire to assign the Leasehold Interest. Although the closing to the transaction will not occur until January of 2023, the thirty (30)-day period is running out so we need the

Resolution in place by next week. Administration has performed due diligence on Alivia Townhomes, LLC and believe it will be a stronger credit than the prior tenant. The resolution authorizes the Superintendent or his designee to execute Consent related documents, along with District's Legal Counsel, Kernan of F3 to review and execute all necessary documents, and to review and approve all loan documents related to the transaction.
