13.1. Approval of Application for Exemption from the Required Expenditures for Classroom **Teachers' Salaries**

Due to the unprecedented Covid-19 Pandemic, during the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the District was required to purchase a significant amount of additional materials and supplies to assure students' continued education while at home, as well as meet the requirements of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health to reopen the District's schools. Per Education Code 41372, 60% of an elementary school district's expenditures are required to be comprised of classroom salaries and benefits. The requirement may be waived if the penalty causes serious hardship to a district. During the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the state and federal governments provided one-time monies with the specific purpose of purchasing these materials and supplies, which affected the proportional spending in the district. These one-time funds count towards this calculation and necessitate the need for a waiver.

Financial Impact

Potential penalty of \$1,722,494.

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the Application for the Exemption from the Required Expenditures for classroom teachers' salaries as presented.
