12. EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

12.1. PUBLIC HEARING: Extended School Year ESY Waiver Submission

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

California Code of Regulations Title 5 Section 3043 (d) requires an extended school year (ESY) program be provided for a minimum of 20 instructional days, including holidays, for students with exceptional needs who have unique needs and require special education and related services in excess of the regular academic year as stated in their Individualized Education Plan. South Whittier School District has applied and been granted a waiver from the state board of education, allowing the operation of ESY since 2014 using fewer days (16) than the required 20 days. The overall instructional minutes has remained the same or increased; however there has been a reduction in days of attendance over a four week period.

PROPOSED WAIVER ACTIONS:

Request waiver for one year from the California State Board of Education to cover ESY for the 2024-2025 school year. Our proposed ESY 2025 will operate Monday-Thursday with 5.25 hours a day of instruction during the weeks of June 16, 2025 to July 10, 2025.

HOW PROPOSED WAIVER IS RELATED TO DISTRICT GOALS:

The modified ESY calendar will support and maximize student learning when delivering a quality instructional program. This will occur by increasing the likelihood that highly qualified and trained classroom teachers and staff working during the school year will apply to work during Extended School Year. It will also facilitate cost effective services within the classroom, and reduce related costs for transportation, electricity, custodial services, food services, administration, etc.
